INDIVIDUAL FOCUS

Upon admission, students are assessed to allow the program to be individually customized. We help students identify their personal vocational, educational, residential, and enrichment goals. Students then build a daily schedule focused on skill development with support from our trained staff.

PROGRAM LENGTH

Because our program is tailored to each student, the length of the program varies based on the student's needs and goals. The average length of stay is 2-4 years.

COST

The cost for a residential student is \$45,000 per year, and \$22,500 per year for day students. Financial aid packages are available and can be individualized to student circumstances.

Program OUTCOMES



The following are the program outcomes we emphasize at ScenicView Academy:

OPENNESS TO LEARN The student demonstrates a willingness to learn and grow in spite of discomfort and some uncertainty.

FUNCTIONAL ABILITY The student demonstrates a basic ability to function in core areas including awareness, communication, and executive functioning.

RELATIONSHIPS The student understands and cultivates safe and appropriate friendships and informal interactions with others, including healthy sexuality.

ACADEMIC POTENTIAL The student has mastered all necessary academic skills and is successfully working toward achieving their fullest educational potential through earning diplomas, certifications, or other appropriate credentials.

JOB READINESS The student develops vocational habits necessary for long term employment success.

OBTAINS & MAINTAINS EMPLOYMENT The student obtains and maintains appropriate, gainful employment optimal for the student's skill level.

TRANSPORTATION The student can get where they need to go using various transportation methods.

HOUSING The student obtains & maintains appropriate off-campus housing.

MONEY MANAGEMENT The student effectively manages money for their current situation and future goals.

BENEFIT & RESOURCE MANAGEMENT The student utilizes community resources and support networks, and seeks relevant benefits necessary to meet personal needs.

FOOD The student provides sufficient food for themselves to stay healthy.

MEDICAL MANAGEMENT The student understands & provides for medical needs.

FUNCTIONAL EDUCATIONAL SKILLS The student has gained proficiency with the basic academic skills they need to reach their educational, vocational, residential, and enrichment goals.

LEISURE The student initiates and participates in appropriate enrichment activities (social and individual; on-campus and off), and works to develop their creative and leisure talents and interests.
